
05.06.2020 - WORD ENVIRONMENT DAY


24.09.2020 - NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME DAY




06.02.2021 CLASS ON FARMING IN GROW BAG




2021 JUNE 14 WORLD BLOOD DONOR DAY

A poster competition to highlight the importance of donating blood was conducted for the volunteers as part of observance of world blood donor day. Out of the 100 responses, 17 posters were selected




2021 JUNE 19 WEBINAR ON GENDER EQUALITY AND POCSO ACT, 2012


<u>2021 JUNE 26 INTERNATIONAL DAY AGAINST DRUGABUSE AND ILLICIT TRAFFICKING</u>

An online Quiz competition was conducted for the volunteers in connection with world population day. All the volunteers attended the quiz.




2021 AUGUST 9 - BHARATH KAAMRUT MAHOTSAV

2021 AUGUST 15 INDEPENDENCE DAY



The volunteers started to cultivate some vegetables using only organic pesticides and fertilizers in their home. We encouraged all the hundred volunteers do this programme compulsorily.








Organic farming in grow bags

In connection with international literacy day an online quiz open to all was conducted though Google form. 89 responses were obtained. E- Certificates were provided to all the participants




