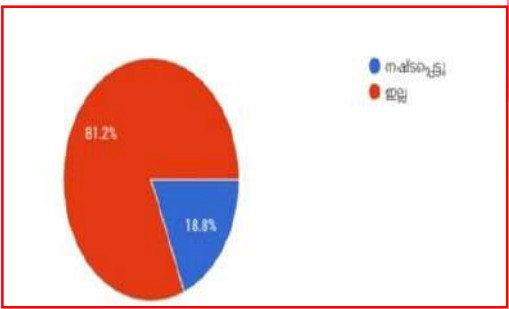

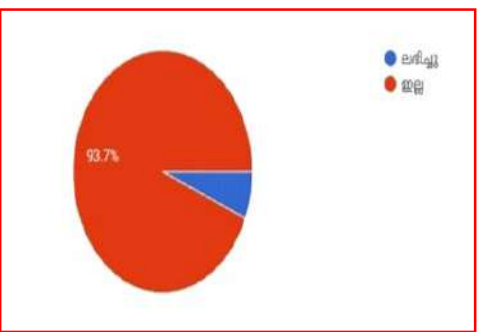

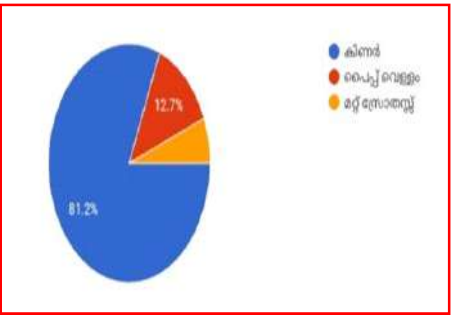

11.02.2021- FACE MASKS AND SANITIZER - PREPARATION

National Service Scheme Unit of SVR NSS College, Vazhoor as part of its social commitment undertook a major step in standing with the poor in the fight against Covid pandemic. It was decided to make and distribute high quality hand sanitizers and face masks and distribute it free of cost among the SC/ST communities, frontline health workers and under privileged sections among the society. With funds raised from among the 100 volunteers and 2 Programme Officers, the unit purchased the ingredients for manufacture of hand sanitizers. Using the same, team of 30 volunteers made 130 litres of sanitizer on 11.02.2021 in the Chemistry lab with technical support of Dr Anoopkumar S, HoD, Department of Chemistry strictly following WHO guidelines. Also, 500 face masks were stitched by the NSS volunteers with the help of their parents.

AUGUST 18 2021-VISIT TO PUNYAM TRUST

Punyam Trust in Sasthankavu situated in Ward 6 (adopted ward) of Vazhoor Grama Panchayath is a charity institution that runs orphanage for children and care home for aged people. Here there are nearly 24 children and 11 adults. The institution takes care of their welfare and also the education of the children. The NSS Unit raised funds with the contribution from each and every one of the 100 volunteers and the 2 Programme officers to provide for the well-being of those inmates.

On 18.08.2021, a team of 15 volunteers, Programme officers and the Principal visited the poor home and handed over cheque for Rs 20,000 /- raised by the NSS unit, for buying new dresses and other essential items for the residents. Besides, one sack rice and other essential commodities were handed over to the Trust for preparing food.

The volunteers thereafter interacted with the inmates. After initial hesitation they slowly gained confidence and mingled with the volunteers. The volunteers promised to make periodical visits to entertain them with games and fun activities and to give the children all possible help in their studies.

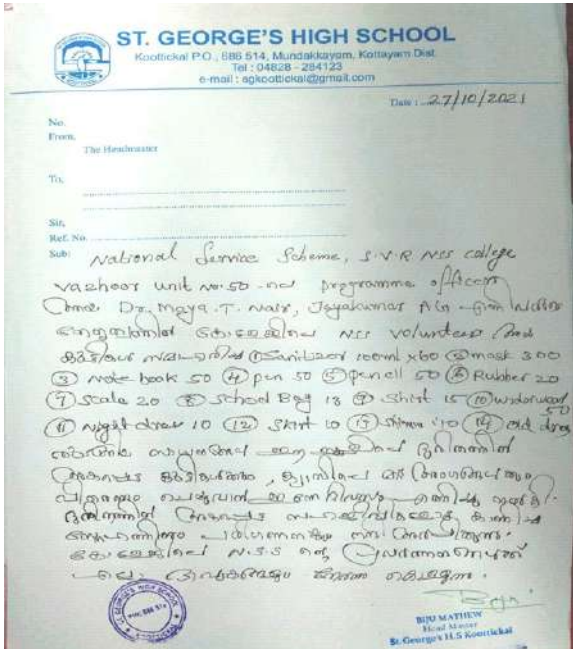

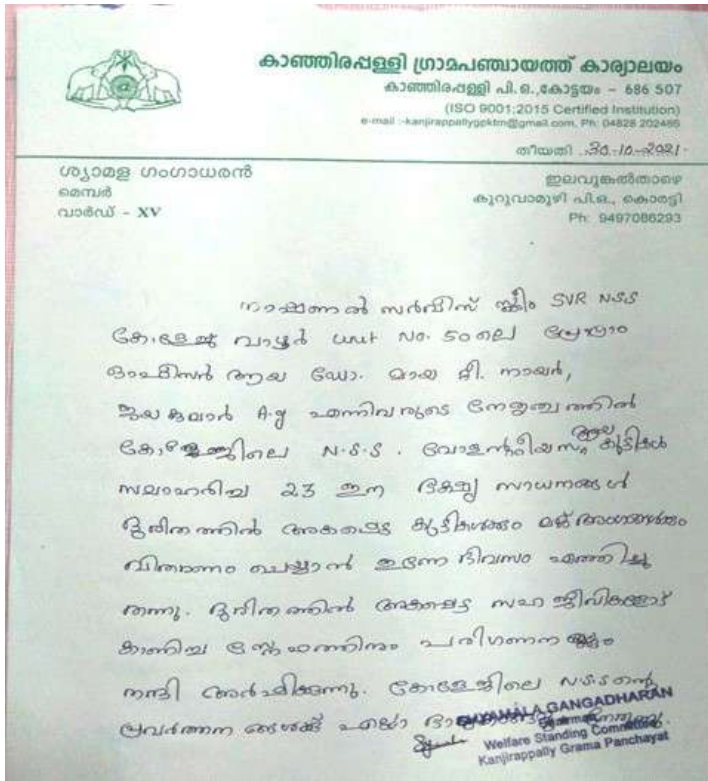
